WHAT'S HAPPENING

Come inspire, create, and connect with other leather workers in this fun Round Robin-Style leather working event. Participation is entirely optional. All ages and skill levels welcome! This event is FREE and open to the public!

WHAT TO BRING

-3-5 tools of your choice (swivel knife, stone, mallet, modeling tools, etc.)
(These tools will remain in your possession the entire event)

HOW IT WORKS

- Each leather worker will have their tools and sit down in front of a piece of leather with a roadrunner image on it.
- Each person spends 15 minutes with their first piece of leather decorating using their own style.
- After the first 15 minutes, the worker passes their piece of leather to the artist next to them and spends 5 minutes building off the previous work.
- The crafter then passes the leather on again and spends 5 minutes building off the incoming, new panel.
- Each crafter leaves with the original piece they spent 15 minutes on that other artists have all contributed to at the end of the event!

There will be additional leather with the roadrunner pattern available for people to participate in carving if they would like to join the fun.
